
With reference to your letter No.UEMK/USUGC/2021/002 dated 28.09.2021 on the subject cited above, I am directed to inform you that the University of Engineering and Management, University Area, Plot No. III-B/5, Main Arterial Road (East-West), New Town, Action Area-III, Kolkata - 700 156, West Bengal has been established by an **Act No.XXV of 2014** of State Legislature of West Bengal as a Private University and is empowered to award degrees as specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act to the students studying in its main campus in regular mode with the approval of Statutory Bodies/Councils, wherever it is required, after creating required academic and physical infrastructure facilities including library, laboratories and appointment of teaching and supporting staff as per the norms and standards laid down by UGC and other relevant Statutory Council(s). The name of University has been included in the list of Universities established as per Section 2(f) of UGC Act, 1956..

University of Engineering and Management, West Bengal is not authorized to open study centre/ off campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the state as per the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yashpal vs. State of Chhattisgarh. The University cannot open its centre(s) even within the state as per the provision of UGC (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 without the approval of UGC.

The UGC has not granted any approval to the University to open off campus/study centre.

No University, whether Central, State, Private or Deemed can offer its programme through franchising arrangement with Private coaching institutions even for the purpose of conducting courses through distance mode.
