


It is a multidisciplinary university focusing on teaching and research and offers various undergraduate, postgraduate and PhD programs.

STRENGTHS

- The university has an active twinning program with industry and foreign universities in research and innovations, conferences, exchange programs etc.
- UEMK is the only university selected from the Eastern region of India to be a part of a FRACTION Project of €69924 involving a consortium of 13 universities.
- The university has active foreign collaboration and annually conducts innumerable
 international conferences in countries like the UK, USA, Canada, Singapore, Australia,
 and Thailand. Eminent Nobel Laureates like Takaaki Kajita of the University of Tokyo,
 Konstantin Novoselov of the National University of Singapore and Muhammad Yunus of
 Bangladesh have graced such occasions. Additionally, numerous seminars, workshops,
 and webinars are conducted regularly.
- Student counselling, psychometric study, and tri-mentoring (faculty, industry, and alumni) are regularly done for the benefit of the students.
- General ambience, atmosphere and discipline are worth mentioning. Intensive preplacement grooming and rigorous training for all the students in all the programs are done in preparation for competitive examinations. The students secure high GATE scores regularly. In the last five years, 6805 students have been awarded scholarships and freeships.

The Central Library of University of Engineering and Management, Kolkata, is also known by the name "Tarun Chandra Dutt Memorial Library". It is spread across an area of 6000 sq ft. and is located at the ground floor of the second building. The library has a spacious reading area, reference and digital sections with six air conditioners and is fully automated. It can accommodate upto 200 users at any point of time. The library has one entry and one exit gate with security guard presence. For enhancing security, thirteen (13) closed circuit cameras (CCTV) have been installed. Fire safeties with six units of fire extinguishers are also available. It remains open 24x7 throughout the year. The working hours of the library range from 9 AM to 5.30 PM, during which, facilities including borrowing/returning/renewal of books, reprographic services, reference services, etc can be availed.

The library includes more than 35,443 books, 110 printed journals, 21 magazines, 1500 back volumes of legal periodicals. The collection of books covers a wide range of subjects such as Engineering, Pure Sciences, Management, Legal Studies, History and Social Sciences, Languages etc. During the last year (2021-2022) total 3249 books were bought.












Solar Hybrid Scooter by IEM

Now we also have to conquer global warming and inflation.

But the question arises, how will an ordinary person continue with their day-to-day activities? How will they commute to their workplace every day? Will those who have purchased petrol-driven twowheelers or cars again spend their hard-earned money to



their hard-earned money to purchase a new electric vehicle? But yet another problem lies with these electric vehicles. While traveling, the battery might get completely discharged and then the only option left would be to push.


In keeping with everyday problems like global warming, inflation and even the unpredictable problems if electric vehicles, Professor Subhamoy Ray, scientist at the Institute of Engineering and Management, has devised groundbreaking technology in the form of a solar hybrid scooter. In this technology, a petrol-driven two-wheeler can be converted to solar hybrid scooter enabling the petrol-powered two-wheeler to run on batteries as well. This provides the options running the vehicle on petrol when the battery is discharged. A solar panel is also installed on the scooter so that the battery can be recharged. This solar panel is detachable and once charging is done, it can be removed, folded and kept in the boot space of the scooter. Also, if needed, the battery can be removed and charged separately anywhere.

It will take one and half-hour to fully charge the Solar Hybrid Scooter. Once fully charged, it can travel up to 100 kilometres. The maximum speed of this vehicle is 80 km per hour on battery mode. It will cost only Rs. 8 to charge it completely, which means it will cost just 80 paisa to travel one kilometre. Thus, this will hugely reduce the tension of price hike.

Above all, this technology will not only be cost-friendly but also eco-friendly.

It will also enable developing international skills, exposing staff for different approaches to learning and research, opportunity to build long-term relationships, all of which could be adopted at their universities. A centre with trained staff and suitable facilities for delivering training on teaching and learning methods, as well as for practicing curriculum design is a long-term expectation in all the three countries. The reason to compose the consortium combines the expertise of EU partners in education field, experience in capacity project implementation and the need of Asian universities to develop their competencies in education field. They will help us to define required profiles (knowledge, skills and competencies) of teacher education experts.

The project has several aspiring objectives:

- Analysis of existing capacity in the HEIs in the field of Teacher Education.
- Development of curricula and accreditation of Postgraduate Program in Teacher Education (PgPTE).
- Set up infrastructure for PgPTE and Distance Learning Platform based on LMS.
- Teacher training of PgPTE.
- Launching Postgraduate Program in Teacher Education (PGgPTE).
- Monitoring & Quality Assurance.
- To encourage cooperation between the EU and Partner Countries and support eligible Partner Countries in addressing challenges in the management and governance of their HEI.
- Improving the quality of higher education, developing new and innovative education programs, modernizing higher education systems through reform policies.







SCHEDULE - "E": NOTES ON ACCOUNTS

SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

- The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Accounting Standards specified by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India
- b) The accounts are prepared on Historical Cost basis and as a going concern. Both income & expenditure items are recognized on accrual basis. Accounting Policies not specifically referred to otherwise are consistent with generally accepted accounting principles.
- Foreign Currency transactions are accounted at the exchange rates prevailing on the date of corresponding credits given by the concerned Banking Authorities.
- d) Fixed Assets are stated at their original cost of acquisition (which includes expenditure incurred for acquisition and / or installation and other attributable costs including financial cost) as reduced by accumulated depreciation thereon. Depreciation on Fixed Assets has been provided for on Written down Value basis, at the rates prescribed under the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- e) Buildings under construction include expenditure incurred for construction and other attributable costs thereon.
- f) Contributions to defined contribution schemes such as Provident Fund, Group Mediclaim, Employees' State Insurance and Pension are charged to the Income & Expenditure Account as and when incurred.
 - The new University has effectively become operational with effect from 21st January, 2015 by virtue of an Ordinance (No. 25 of 2014) promulgated by the Governor of the State of West Bengal on 21st January, 2015 [vide publication of the Notification of the said ordinance in the Rajasthan Gazette on 03rd February, 2015]. Later on it becomes an act called University of Engineering & Management Kolkata Act, 2014. In this connection, the Trust has created a sum of Rs. 10.00 Crores and Rs.1.00 crore in the form of fixed deposit with Indian Overseas Bank, Sector

- V Branch towards Endowment Fund and Security Deposit with the Department of Higher

Education, Govt. of West Bengal in terms of University of Engineering & Management Kolkata Act, 2014 and against which interest accrued has been accounted for. Trust have created also two nos. bank guarantee of Rs.10.00 crore dated 28.06.2018 and Rs.1.00 crore dated 28.06.2018 towards endowment fund and security deposit respectively issued by Indian Overseas Bank, Sector-V Branch in favour of Department of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal.


