To explain the complete examination rules formulated after incorporating one SWAYAM / NPTEL subject exam every semester and which was approved by the Board of Management in its meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> December, 2017.

The complete examination rules formulated after necessary alterations and incorporations were presented to the Academic Council for consideration. The necessary presentation for explanation was given.

Members suggested the following changes:-

- i) NPTEL exam was suggested to incorporated as one of the compulsory papers from 2<sup>nd</sup> semester to 7<sup>th</sup> semester.
- ii) Students having 65% 75% attendance are allowed to appear for examination under special cases.
- iii) If students fail in Practical exam, students will have year lag.
- iv) Improvement test upto 1 year, where if students get more marks, then his marks can be improved; administration supervision is necessary. However this needs to be discussed further.
