The Academic CouncilMembers raised few points mentioned below:-

- i) Vice-Chancellor mentioned that the University of Engineering & Management (UEM), Jaipur has 5 all India toppers amongst faculties and around 11 India toppers amongst students. However, because of NPTEL examinations 14% of students have supplementary in papers such as IOT which are new subject where students are facing problem, but he expressed his analysis that these will gradually be smoothened out.
- ii) Prof. Basudeb Barman proposed that teachers needs to update themselves on new technologies from time to time that teachers can sit together once in 7 months and update their technical knowledge.
- iii) Pro-Vice-Chancellor metioned that participatory workbooks are being followed religiously which will gradually be digitized.
- iv) Vice-Chancellor said that in the new syllabus government job related training is incorporated.

There will be a scholarship of 10% for local students of Rajasthan.
