- i) Vice Chancellor pointed out that to improve the attendance of students, a change in the marking policy should be in effect as per Annexure 5. Total exam will be of 200 marks for each paper. 100 marks will be for end semester exam, and 100 marks internal (divided into 60 marks and 40 marks), 60 for continuous assessment and 40 marks for completing workbook which will be taken online every day after the classes (Detailed in Annexure 5).
- ii) Dr. Basudeb Barman said that in last 10 minutesstudentscan give their feedback about the understanding of the subject. He also suggested that the students may be given 5 marks for participation in feedback, which was suggested to be considered later.
- iii) Pro-Vice Chancellormentioned that there is no substitute of class teaching method. Class participation is very important and online lectures are an addition.
- iv) Prof. Subhash Panja raised a point that class timing is decreasing to which Prof. Basudeb Barman proposed that 40 minutes of class teaching should be increased to 45 minutes and may be considered later.
- v) Pro Vice Chancellor said that instead of NPTEL students can give exams in other approved MOOCS.

The Council members suggested further consideration on the same before approval.
