# Agenda Item No-3

To regularize and seek final approval for the classes, exams and improvement exams held in online mode and results declared for the same for the previous semester – January to June, 2020 during pandemic.

All classes of previous semester have been conducted in online mode from 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2020 (as the first University in India to start doing so), due to lockdown imposed during pandemic. Classes have been held mainly using Google Meet and Goto Meeting. Assignments were given and checked using Google Classroom. Exams were also held online in the form of a first assessment between 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 and 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2020. Improvement exams were held between 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2020 and 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2020. Results have been announced dated 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2020 for final years and 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2020 for other years.

Approval for the same were taken through circulation. Placed for discussion and final approval.

Classes for this semester have also been started from 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2020 for students of 2<sup>nd</sup> year to final year and from 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2020 for first year in form of bridge classes. Placed for regularization of the same.

To regularize and seek final approval for acceptance of IEM Learning / Coursera / Unacademy / Udemy courses in lieu of NPTEL for the previous semester – January to June, 2020, when NPTEL was not conducted during pandemic.

### Agenda Item No-6

To seek approval for conduct of special examinations in view of the current pandemic.

In view of the current pandemic, we hereby propose to conduct special backlog examination for students who failed to obtain degree due to multiple supplementaries. This is proposed as a very special case keeping the pandemic in view. The students who took admission in 2016 for 4 years degree program, in 2017 for 3 years degree programs and 2018 for 2 years degree programs and were eligible to get a degree this year, may be eligible for availing this special supplementary. It is being proposed keeping in view the amount of impact, the failure to obtain degree along with peer students, may create upon the minds of the students amidst the pandemic. This is a special opportunity being given to the students and will be treated on complete merit.

Placed for approval of the Council. If approved, the special exam may be conducted during October end to November middle. Approximately 8 students will be eligible for that.

The Council members approved the same.

# Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.

Admission is a concern in the current year amidst the pandemic as students from other states (which is a major portion of admission for all other years in all Universities of Rajasthan) is less. Also students from Rajasthan are opting to drop a year, owing to the halts in business, which is the major profession of people in Rajasthan. Major Universities are providing 100% scholarships to the students in the first year, but doing that even partially, may cause major upset amongst the current students of the University, and hence not suggested or proposed.

Fees collection from students is also a problem during pandemic, and the University runs only in students' fees.
