10. Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.

- i. 10% of the students of the University shall be considered as special talented students. It is expected that students who are involved in entrepreneurial activities, innovative projects, games and sports (representation in minimum state level), cultural activities, organization of events might have few supplementary papers in their examination. It is proposed that the exam regulation 1.5 stating that students will not be promoted to higher years of study, if they are carrying more than 4 supplementary papers, will not hold good for these students. However, they will need to clear all supplementary papers within the prescribed maximum time of passing the course in order to get the degree. The eligibility of the student to be considered as a special talented student will be judged by a three committee member comprising of one member from the Board of Management as nominated by the Chancellor, one member from the Academic Council as nominated by the Board of Management, and one external member as nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.

Chancellor requested Prof. Basudeb Barman to formulate rules for handling the exceptional cases of special talented students.

- ii. The students of BPT (Bachelor of Physiotherapy) goes through a 9 semester course duration, out of which in first 8 semesters, they are subject to classroom study in the University with occasional hospital visits. However, in the 9th semester, they are required to go for internships, and stay the whole semester at the hospitals doing the internship. There is no examination at the end of 9th semester. However, the students need to provide their internship report, which after being judged and validated by the University, the course is certified to be complete, and the student gets eligible for degree (provided he/she does not have any pending backlogs in previous semesters). It is proposed that the University will not charge any tuition fees for the 9th semester, and the tuition fees will be charged only for 8 semesters.

Placed before the Board for approval.

Chancellor proposed that 9th semester students have to take admission by only giving Rs. 1 since, 9th semester students have to go for internship in different institutes (institutes names must be suggested by University). Monthly evaluation of the internship status should be carried out by faculties of UEM for free of cost.

- iii. 25th August, 2019 is proposed for the date of convocation of the University, where degrees will be awarded to 2018 batch passout students.
