Total exam will be of 200 marks for each paper. 100 marks will be for end semester exam, and 100 marks internal (divided into 60 marks and 40 marks), 60 for continuous assessment and 40 marks for completing workbook which will be taken onlineeveryday after the classes (Detailed in Annexure 5).
- ii) Dr. T.K. Nathpointed that it is difficult for the University to deal with students who fail in internal as Internal marks cannot be improved. Hence, failure in a paper only based on internal marks is not practically possible. Hence, Chancellor agreed that everything in Annexure 5 remains the same apart from failure through internal marks. Failure will have to be considered only based on the entire marks of the paper.
